In order to provide a safe and effective installation process and to install your propane tank as efficiently as possible, we have established the following guidelines necessary to ensure your tank is set and your piping system is pressured tested and inspected properly. It is our goal to finalize everything during the initial installation process. Please make certain the following items have been checked and completed prior to Sevier County Propane arriving for your tank installation to avoid additional and unnecessary trips.

\_\_\_\_\_ All appliances that will use propane **MUST** be connected and gas piping plumbed to the outside wall for connection. If appliances need to be converted to propane it must be completed prior to our arrival.

\_\_\_\_\_ Corrugated stainless steel tubing or CSST must be grounded to the main electrical ground before installation. This requirement is code.

\_\_\_\_\_ All propane appliances that utilize electricity must have the electricity available prior to our arrival.

\_\_\_\_\_ There must be someone available to give our installer access to the inside of the home to finalize set up and inspection.

\*\*\*If the above items have not been completed prior to Sevier County Propane arriving for the initial tank installation, there will be a service charge of \$75.00 for each additional return trip.\*\*\*
